## **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. This team competition is open to all players living within the Manawatu region, plus players affiliated to Associations within the Central Region.
- 2. The Rules of play shall be those of the BWF. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6. The whole of the shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib, and the shaft and racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction. The Referee or Tournament Controller shall decide all questions regarding Rules of the game.
- 3. Entries are strictly limited to 24 teams maximum. First in, first served based on the online entry timestamp. Enter early to avoid disappointment.
- 4. The intention is for all events to be played as round robins with playoffs for all teams to determine a final placing. The intention is that all teams will play 3 or 4 ties over the two days, however, the final format of competition will be at the discretion of the Tournament Controller and based upon the number of entries.
- 5. Teams to be comprised of a minimum of four players and a maximum of six players.
- 6. Teams must rank pairings in advance of each tie and agree these with the opposing team. All disputes will be resolved at the time by the Tournament Controller and not be subject to further appeal.

7. Entry requirements for each grade:

- 8. Ties will be comprised of four doubles matches, consisting of one men's doubles, one women's doubles, and two mixed doubles matches.
- 9. All matches shall be the best of three games to 21 as per the BWF regulations. Round robin scoring will follow the BWF format. If teams finish with equal matches, games & points won, then a golden game will be used to determine a winner. One game to 21, with teams able to select any two players to compete.
- 10. Feather shuttles will be used for all matches.
- 11. The Tournament Controller reserves the right to:
  - a) Amend the hours of play.
  - b) Cancel the tournament if there are less than 16 team entries.

- c) Alter division allocation.
- d) Default any team(s) not present at the correct court(s) for the start of a tie.
- 12. Non-marking shoes must be worn.
- 13. Play will commence at 9am on Saturday and 9am on Sunday.
- 14. All players enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury suffered during the tournament.
- 15. Teams withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund.
- 16. Only online entries will be accepted. Online entry is available on the Tournament Software website here:

Payments must be cleared in our account by Wednesday 25 September, otherwise teams will be withdrawn without any further notice.

- 17. The draw and schedule will be published on or before Wednesday 2 October and will be available on the tournament software website.
- 18.
